## Celebrate May Day - Spring Wildflowers and Birding



Friday, May 4 to Sunday, May 6

Limited to 12 participants.  
Cost is \$40 per person and includes all meals.



The weekend begins with supper on Friday evening and concludes with a simple lunch on Sunday. Activities are planned to find early spring wildflowers that are abundant on Camp Woodbrooke's 162 acres and to see which spring birds have already arrived. There will be evening walks to listen for spring peepers and other frogs and to view the night sky.



And there will be some free time to use as participants choose. Everyone will share in some of the meal preparation and clean-up. Sleeping arrangements will be in enclosed buildings, but participants bring their own warm sleeping bags, pillows and flashlights. Some of the spaces have no electricity.

Be sure to bring appropriate outdoor wear for the weather that southern Wisconsin is having that week. Warm jackets, hats, gloves would be good. You will need sturdy shoes that can handle some wetness and binoculars for birdwatching.
